# FLORIN COUNTY WATER DISTRICT JANUARY 2024 NEWSLETTER



The Florin County Water District is approximately 2.5 square miles and services 2,105 customers. Florin County Water District has been providing clean, good safe water to the Florin area since 1959.

**Projects in the District/Update:** Currently, and in the next few weeks, you will see our trucks and equipment working throughout the District on these projects:

- Replacing main and service lines on Tommy Circle and Judette Avenue.
  - Residents in that area have been notified of this major work being planned.

\*There maybe some interruption of traffic that may happen during this work, so be safe — and make the District workers safe, too. Work is expected to begin the first part of 2024.

**Other News:** California Law (SB522) requires all water use to be checked with meters. The State says: <u>Meters must be used to track water use and correct water loss (leaks).</u>

Through the meters, users can know (with the use of instant messaging, etc.) what their own water use is and permit **you** to reduce water use with conservation measures. The District employees are presently installing meter setters that allow for the installation of meters when they are State required no later than 2032.

To comply with the Environmental Protection Agencies' (EPA) requirement, we are making an inventory of service line materials (galvanized, copper, PVC, etc.) and identifying the locations.

**Meet your General Manager:** General Manager Edmond Leggette has worked for Florin County Water District for 17 years and has served as General Manager since September 2022. As General Manager, Edmond Leggette is responsible for the day-to-day operations and upkeep of the District. That means making sure that all customers receive good clean water at a reasonable price.

**Meet your Board of Directors:** The Florin County Water District has a Board of Directors with members who are elected or appointed. The Board is responsible for oversight of the District – and that means responding timely to you!
